CURRENCY

For those of you who come from the States, you can get your CANADIAN CURRENCY at any of several ATMs in Edmundston. Those who want AMERICAN CURRENCY can get it at several ATMs in Madawaska or Van Buren. This is usually more economical than purchasing it at your local Financial Institution. Most of your charges should be put on your Credit Card and the Credit Card Company will do the conversions for you at the prevailing rate. Currently the rate has been around 2 for 3. i.e. \$20 U.S. will get you \$30 Canadian. If you use the ATM and get \$100 of Canadian, your Financial Institution will charge your account around \$66 to \$68 depending on the rate of exchange for that day.
